

# MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

There are numerous deterrents to housing security: poverty, financial literacy, barriers to employment, substance use disorder, and discrimination. At SELF, we strive to address systemic inequities that exacerbate barriers to housing. As one of the largest providers of emergency housing in the city of Philadelphia we provide services to address mental health, substance use disorders, and health inequities and their impact on homelessness.

Early this summer, a Supreme Court ruling upheld the ban on sleeping outdoors. This decision effectually criminalizes homelessness.



It is imperative to address the impact of this type of ruling on the unhoused. This ruling empowers law enforcement to arrest or issue tickets to the unhoused. Permitting police to arrest people that are unhoused will only worsen their problems. Once a person gets an arrest record, housing and employment opportunities significantly decrease.

This decision fails to address systemic inequities, perpetuates continued prejudices against those experiencing homelessness, and place them at risk of further marginalization. At SELF we are intentional about partnering with other human service organizations to provide the support, treatment, and resources needed to help our participants gain housing security.

We provide housing and employment assistance at all locations. To help raise funds to address the needs of those we serve we are having our lnaugural Gala in November 2024. This gala will raise significant funds to support our various programs and services, including emergency housing, temporary and rapid rehousing for adults and young people ages 18-24, food distribution, and wellness programs for those with substance use disorder.

Each nomination must include a short paragraph (200 words or less) outlining why this person should receive this honor during our inaugural "SELF in the City" Gala on Saturday, November 16, 2024. Deadline for entries is Thursday, September 26, 2024.

## **NOMINEE CRITERIA:**

- **1.** The nominee must be a resident of Philadelphia, 18-24 years old and have been involved with homelessness as a volunteer or have lived experience and/or community or civic engagement.
- **2. LEADERSHIP:** Someone who makes significant contributions that have positively impacted the lives of homeless individuals or the community.
- **3. SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:** A young person who assists others in improving their communities through volunteerism, social groups, outreach centers, sports programs, or after-school groups.
- **4. CHANGE AGENT:** A young person who influences or stimulates others to effect positive changes through personal development or self-improvement.
